

Add-on CONDITIONS addendum – (Rev 2019-01-16)

The application, integration, functionality, data set or other feature, materials, or data requested by you including any future update or upgrade thereto (“**add-on**”) is made available by MEGA International under the terms and conditions of this addendum (“addendum”) and may solely be used with the HOPEX Platform. This addendum is a legal agreement between MEGA and the LICENSEE who download the add-on. If you do not agree to this agreement, do not click “Agree” and do not download the add-on and do not use the add-on.

You accept this addendum by downloading, installing, accessing or using the add-ons provided by MEGA International from the HOPEX Store and is effective as of the first date of use. You also represent and warrant that the company is an authorized user of the HOPEX Platform under a proper licensing agreement. If you are agreeing to this addendum (a) as an individual, you have the capacity to accept it or (b) on behalf of your employer or other entity you have the authority to act on its behalf and to bind it to this addendum. If your company does not accept this addendum, your company must not access or use the MEGA add-on. This addendum will control to the extent of any conflict with the Master Software License and Maintenance Services Agreement (SLMA) or Master Software As a Service Agreement (MSASA) solely as applicable to the MEGA add-on.

1. MEGA ADD-ON. The MEGA add-on available hereunder is deemed part of the SLMA or MSASA and all HOPEX Platform agreements apply to its use except as expressly provided herein. MEGA add-on may require access to a particular HOPEX Platform solution, product or service as described in the add-on documentation applicable to the add-on. Use of the add-on grants no use right to the underlying HOPEX Platform or service required for its use. In the event of the expiration or termination of LICENSEE access to any HOPEX Platform solution, product or service required to run this add-on, no further rights are granted to LICENSEE to such product or service to enable LICENSEE continue use of, or access to, the MEGA add-on.

2. CONNECTIONS TO THIRD-PARTY SERVICES. Add-on may include software that enables LICENSEE to call or connect to third-party products or services, including but not limited to, application program interfaces and connectors (“**Interoperability features**”). Interoperability features are subject to licenses granted by the third-party product or service provider or an open source community, and LICENSEE may lose access to interoperability features at any time, without notice. Any information LICENSEE transmits using Interoperability Features is subject solely to the applicable third party’s policies and procedures regarding storage, retention, and processing of data once outside the HOPEX Platform. Use of the products or services accessible through Interoperability Features may be subject to the terms and conditions and fees of third parties. No rights to third-party products or services are granted by this Addendum or use of the Interoperability Features. MEGA International makes no representations or warranties, and has no liabilities or obligations (including to provide any refund, updates, or support) whatsoever regarding Interoperability Features. MEGA International will not be liable to LICENSEE for any special, incidental, punitive, consequential, or other indirect damages (including for loss of data or profits) related to interoperability features. The maximum aggregate liability to LICENSEE of MEGA International regarding interoperability features is limited to direct damages incurred in

reasonable reliance in an amount not to exceed two (2) thousand dollars.

3. ADD-ON Support. The MEGA add-on support policy is not tight to the HOPEX Platform support policy. The lifecycle of each add-on is defined on the HOPEX Store. MEGA does not commit to support, maintain add-on based on the lifecycle of the HOPEX Platform. In case of termination of the add-on MEGA grants access to the add-on source code to enable LICENSEE to maintain and evolve the add-on according to his needs.

4. ADD-ON Lifecycle and environments for use. Add-on are released on the HOPEX Store with an environment to use for and a lifecycle status. Used for environment means the LICENSEE environment where the add-on can be deployed. Two values are possible: Production and Development. Production means for HOPEX Platform production environment and Development means for development, test, UAT or pre-production environments. Lifecycle status are composed of four possible values: under active development, maintenance and fixes only, no further development, obsolete. Under active development means MEGA is investing in updating this add-on and updates may be released every month, quarter, semester. Maintenance and fixes only means only bugs and platform alignment will be done on this add-on. No further development means the add-on is not supported anymore and is used by the LICENSEE at his own risk. Obsolete means the add-on should not be used anymore and the use of the add-on may cause damage to the HOPEX Platform that will remove any warranty from the SLMA or MSASA. MEGA grants itself the right to change the status of the add-on without any notice to the LICENSEE. In any case the lifecycle status of the add-on is guaranteed for a period or duration and is not aligned with the HOPEX Platform lifecycle policy.
